

VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

Position: Public Health Officer

Background: Supporting subnational governments in strengthening of Public Health Governance System through Policy Formulation and Implementation to enhance the inclusivity and evidence-based nature of selected local governments' policies and plans to access better public health services. The project focuses on two key areas: Health Governance & Local Health System Strengthening and Policy Dialogue & Discussion Meetings. This project aims to provide assistance and support in four municipalities of Nepal-Waling, Bhimeswor, Damak, and Tikapur.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the PPP program team as needed to support project implementation and foster favorable relations with the municipality.
- Provide mentoring support to facilitate regular meetings of the Social Development Committee (SDC), Health Facility Operation & Management Committee, and other health working committees.
- Collaborate with municipal stakeholders, including committees and health officials, to gather inputs and align policies with local health needs and priorities.
- Coordinate the implementation of public health policies, ensuring adherence to guidelines and protocols at various levels.
- Monitor implementation progress, identify challenges, and propose solutions to overcome them.
- Conduct capacity-building activities for local health committee members, stakeholders, and health workers to enhance their understanding of public health policies.
- Support training, mentorship, and development of resources for the local health workforce on policy-related topics.
- Coordinate data collection from health facilities for policy planning, development, and monitoring purposes.
- Analyze collected data to assess policy impact and effectiveness, identifying areas for improvement.
- Prepare reports and presentations summarizing key findings and recommendations from data analysis.
- Maintain close coordination with the municipality's health section for effective collaboration and communication.
- Provide regular monthly reports on policy formulation and implementation, including challenges, successes, and recommendations for improvement.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in public health or social sciences with at least three years working experience in the relevant area.
- Good understanding on health governance, policymaking, and implementation.
- Excellent facilitation, communication, interpersonal and report writing skills.
- Time management skills and excellent organizational skills.
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively.
- Local applicants will be given higher priority.

Duration and Location: The recruitment will be for a period of 8 months starting from the date of Orientation. The Public Health Officers will be stationed primarily at the respective municipalities, with frequent travel to other locations down to ward level community.
